If you ever leave Creekside at rush hour, you know how bad the traffic has gotten on Westport Road. It's becoming increasingly more dangerous and difficult to get in out of our community.

At one time, the developer of the apartments was to install a light. As public policy issues go, that requirement has somehow been eliminated. Metro Council representatives don't see the importance of additional traffic controls along Westport Road, however if there was one at the entrance to the apartments it would allow a break in the traffic and give commuters time to enter and exit Creekside.

The Creekside City Council is encouraging you to **write, call or visit** Councilman Glen Stuckel and let him know how concerned we are about traffic on Westport Road.
